RAILS - TO - TRAILS

Rails to Trails is a walking trail constructed on an abandoned railroad track bed. This trail can be accessed from Kahler Road South and runs both east and west. The trail runs parallel to and between Interstate 86 and County Route 64 for approximately 1.7 miles. Anyone is free to walk, run, or bicycle the trail. Motorized vehicles are prohibited. Have you ever wanted to soar above the earth in a glider? Now is your chance! The Harris Hill Soaring Center offers sailplane rides over the Harris Hill valley. From the first weekend of April to the last weekend of October, sailplane rides are available weekends only from 10:00am to 6:00pm, weather and conditions permitting. During the summer, sailplane rides are available seven days a week from the end of June to Labor Day weekend. Please contact the center to confirm the dates for each summer. It is also recommended that you contact the center to be sure that conditions are conducive to flight. All of the center's pilots are FAA certified. Flights take place in either a Schleicher ASK-21 or a Schweizer SGS 2-33 Trainer sailplane.

Dedicated to the memory of pioneer aviator, Glenn Curtiss, the museum contains a priceless collection relating to early aviation and local history.
